Senior High Special Education Registration

As we register students with Special Education needs, it is always helpful to keep in mind that we would like to place students according to skill, maturity, behavior, and testing score level. **Placing students by age or grade level is secondary in importance.**

Vocational classes

VE102A&B and VE103A&B (+Career/Acad. and +Career Vistas) are freshman level Resource classes. A student will take +Career/Academic one period and +Career Vista 1 another. During Career Academics, students work on resume' writing skills, filling out applications, practice interviewing, researching careers, etc. During Career Vistas, students will do a variety of jobs around the school like making coffees/lattes, working the school store, working the cafeteria (sweeping & cleaning tables), etc.

VE410A&B (+OJT) are classes for students that are at 2-5 grade level skills. These classes (offered by the hour only for schedule fluidity) are generally a two or three-hour block. These Life Skills students will generally go into the community, go to stores and businesses, learn to navigate the Met Bus system, or go to a job or an assignment in the community where they are dropped off and then picked up when finished. These students' skill levels, behaviors included, range from grade 2-5.

The goal is for these students going from a supervised situation to where they do not need school adult supervision at all.

VE120A&B Vocational Training are classes for students that are K-1 grade level. In class these students work on assembly line production of paperwork jobs for teachers, shredding, wash desks and chairs, empty and replace garbage can liners in hallways etc.

VE210A&B Occ. Skills classes work on Math, English, Reading, etc.
